Abstracts Submission Guidelines

Abstracts should not exceed 250 words. Instructions as following: **Font:** *Times New Roman*; **Size:** 12, **Title:** *bold font*; Authors addresses and affiliation underneath the title; and presenting author underlined. Abstracts should include sections titled **Introduction, Objectives, Methodology, Results, and Conclusion**. Key words should be included at the bottom of the page. File types for submissions should be in Microsoft Word or Portable Document Format (PDF). Indicate your presentation type preference (oral presentation or poster) with your submission. Presentations may be delivered in English or French, but electronic documents (the abstract, PowerPoint presentations, or poster) must be provided in English. Participation is free of charge.
