





Call for Application for Ph.D. fellowship

To apply for this fellowship, you must:

- 1. Be a Malian or Guinean who holds a relevant Master's degree
- 2. Be a highly motivated individual interested in working on Emerging Infectious Diseases (EID) in relation to one or more of the following Research themes:
 - Epidemiology,
 - Bacteriology-virology.
 - Public health
 - Molecular biology
 - Bioinformatics
 - Pandemic preparation

The successful fellows will be enrolled at the USTTB or UGANC.

The successful Ph.D. fellow will be expected to:

- Conduct high-quality research leading to the publication of at least 2 papers in peer-reviewed journals.
- Contribute to the training of Master students.
- Graduate from the USTTB or UGANC Doctoral School
- Have published (or co-authored) at least one peer-reviewed article.

The Ph.D. fellowship will cover:

- 1. Tuition at the USTTB or UGANC
- 2. Possible two to eight-week visit to Johns Hopkins University (JHU) in Baltimore
- 3. Other related costs (such as international conferences, courses, and workshops)
- **4.** But will not cover the costs of implementing the research study, and the student should have another source of funding for conducting the study
